GKN El Cajon – New site with increased capacity & Capabilities



GKN has approved a growth move for El Cajon to be taken throughout 2024 which will see us moving to a brand new facility

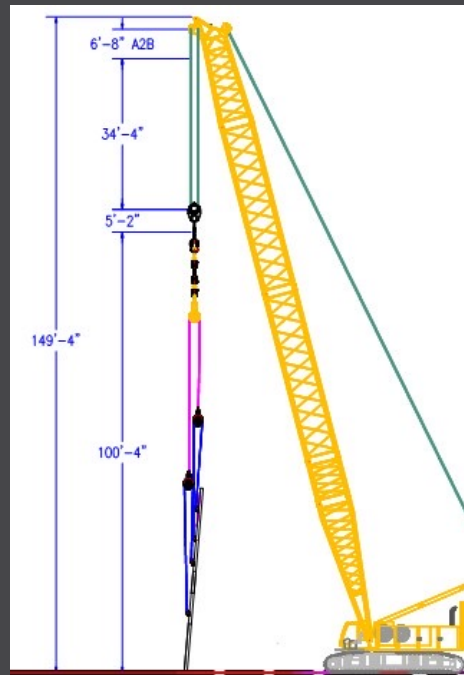

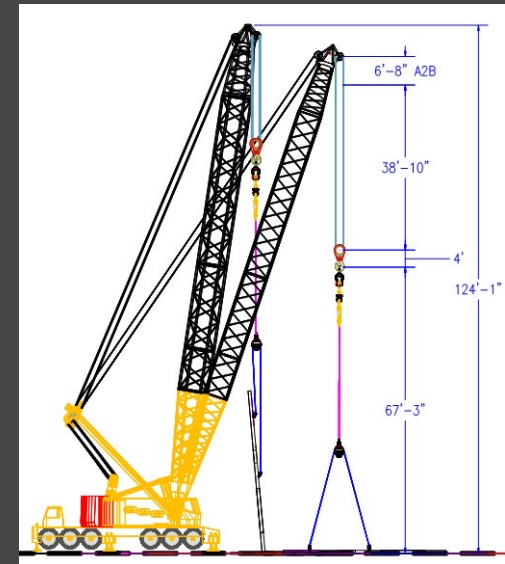

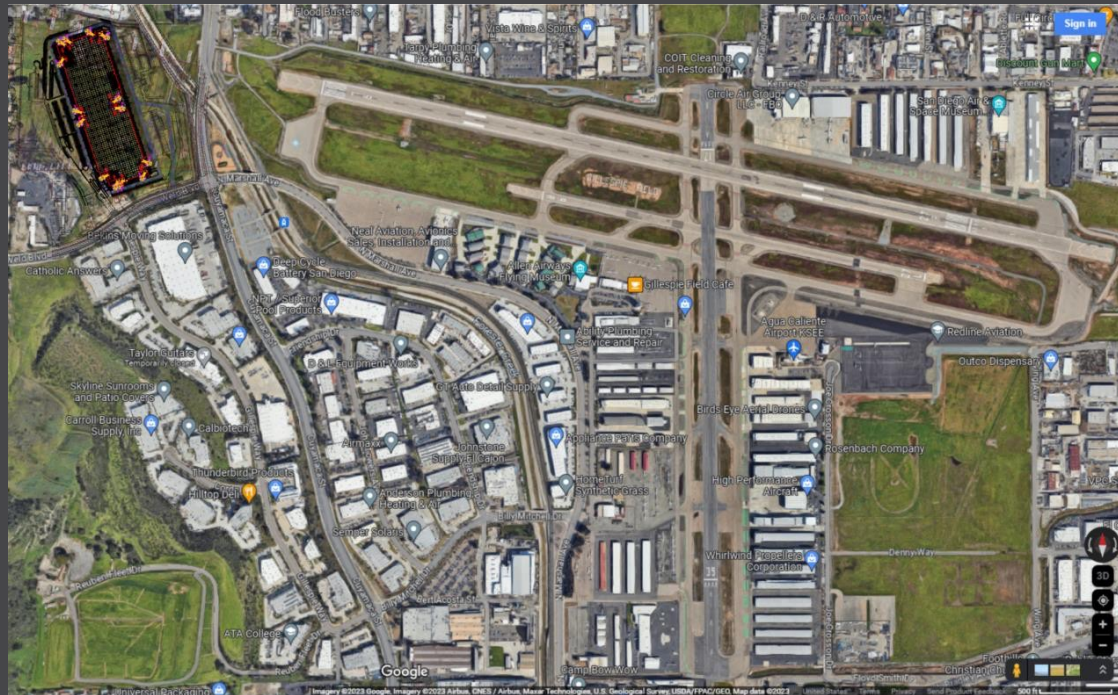

GALA Agenda – talking points



Major Points Summarized – *“Focus as much on economic sustainability as you do on environmental sustainability, and our airport will thrive...”*

- History of San Diego County Airport leasing practices
- Goal posts moved by County staff with no stakeholder input
 - County investment in infrastructure 10%
 - Federal Govt 90% in infrastructure
 - All buildings at KSEE are from private investment
- 50-year lease law provided by bothy Federal and State
- **SB 654** bi-partisan bill passed unanimously – *it is Law Jan 1, 2024*
- County interaction with **FAA** --- they are *attempting to force a ruling*
 - FAA compliance manual is silent when it comes to serial leases.
 - Forcing an **FAA Policy Guidance Letter** is a **HUGE mistake**.
 - It is also a delaying tactic - (*for what purpose?*)
- Serial leases never longer than 50 years at a time (Federal)

Major Points Summarized – The airport is not thriving – *it is in a spiral of non-investment*

- New **50-year leases** needed to: **amortize investments**
 - including new sustainability features, encouraging new airport investment,
 - ability to sell an existing lease, ability to refinance, maintaining a stable property tax base for the County
- Alignment of “**on-airport**” and “**off-airport**” leasing practices
 - So the lease term does not start till the certificate of occupancy
- Reviewed numerous impacts to stakeholders caused by the County's inability to issue new leases
- Reviewed capital markets and lease length impacts
- Status of the pandemic 5-year lease extension for all leaseholders?
- **El Cajon Flying Service** leases month to month
 - should be offered a new 50-year lease!
- Why is the **Sky Harbor Lease** not out for RFP? 3 years?
 - **This is unfair competition against private stakeholders**
 - The county does not pay property tax or land lease enabling in direct competition cheaper
- RFPs not needed - 'free market', advertising gives the highest price & public participation
- **Property tax** to the general fund **decreases** as leases near-term
 - Property value is -0- to the stakeholder at the end of the lease with no ability to renew or sell.
- County deliverables in one week

- Students have in-depth guided tour of KCRQ or KSEE Airports which last 120 minutes.
- Tours cover various areas of the airport, such as Fixed Based Operators (FBO), hangars containing many aircraft, flight schools, flying clubs, and maintenance facilities.
- Students have the opportunity to learn about the different roles and functions within the aviation industry and meet professionals such as pilots, mechanics, air traffic controllers, and airport management personnel.

- Qualified HS students receive familiarization flight in GA aircraft which lasts 20 minutes per person.



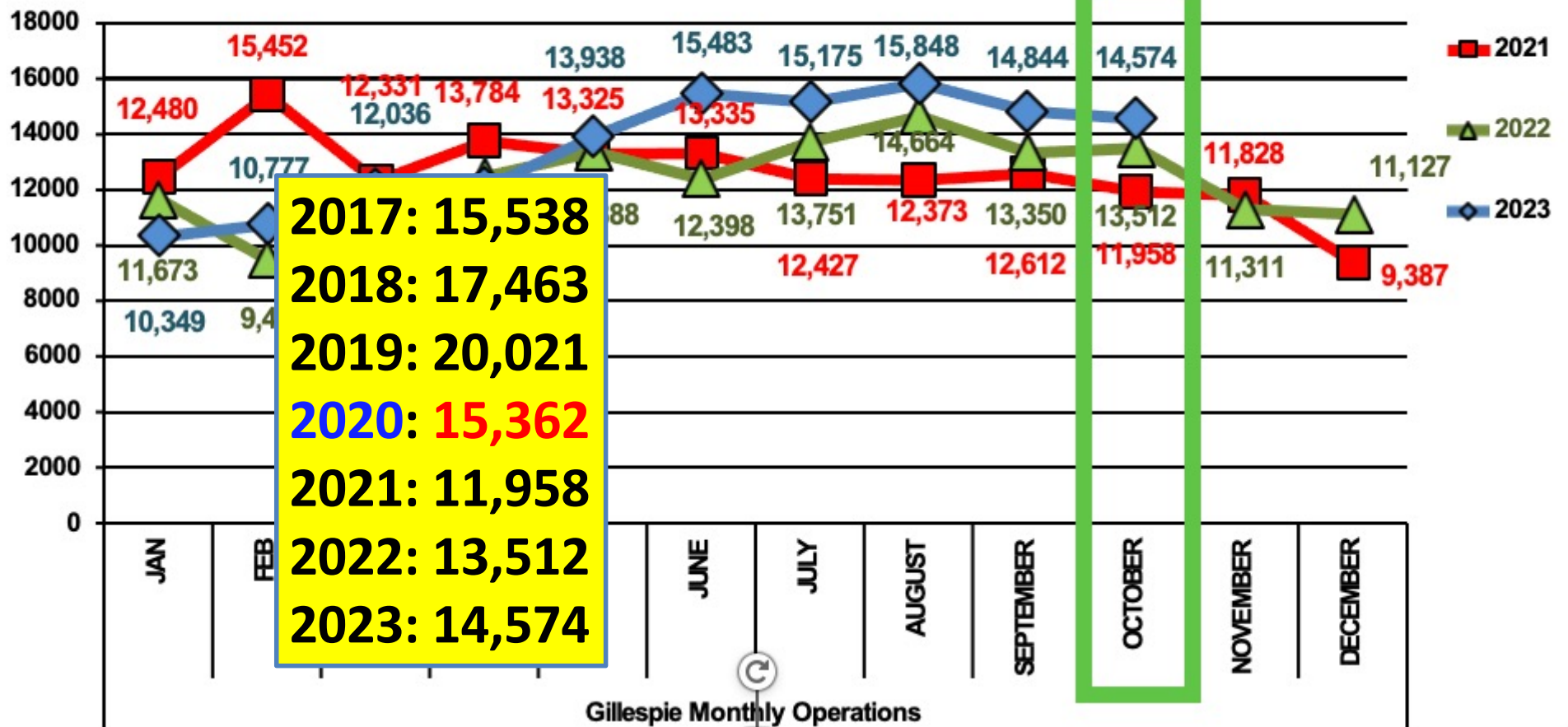

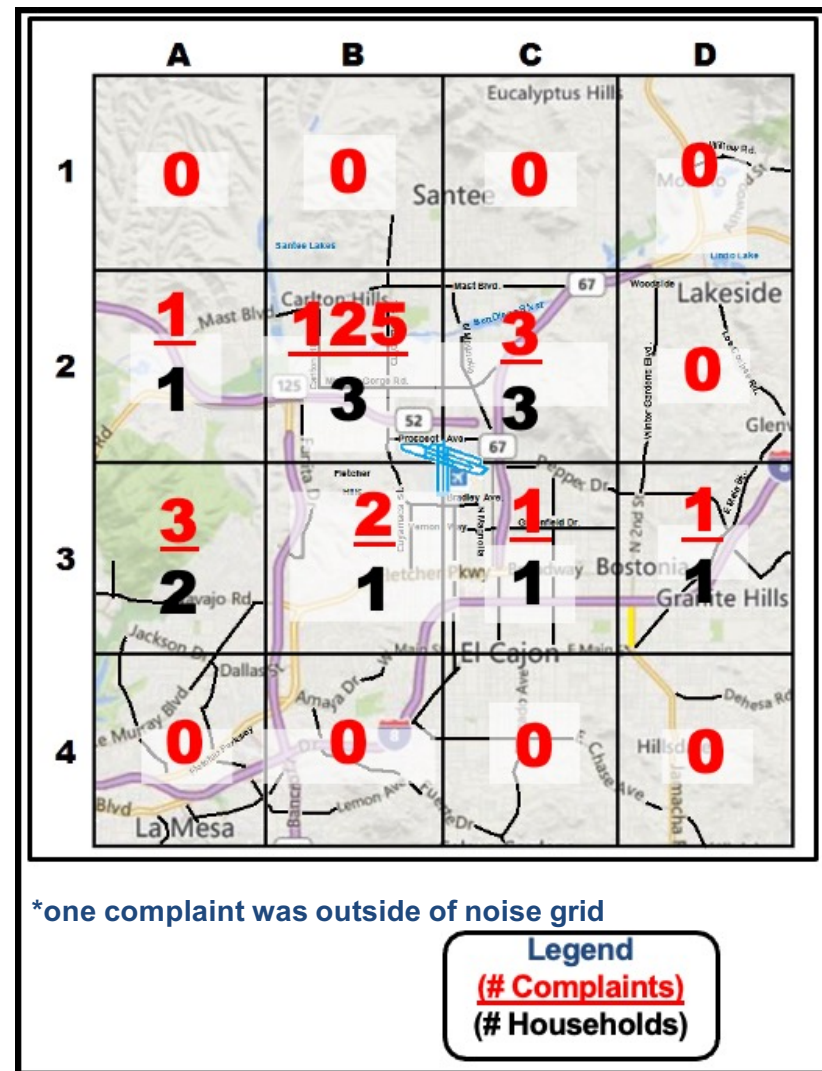

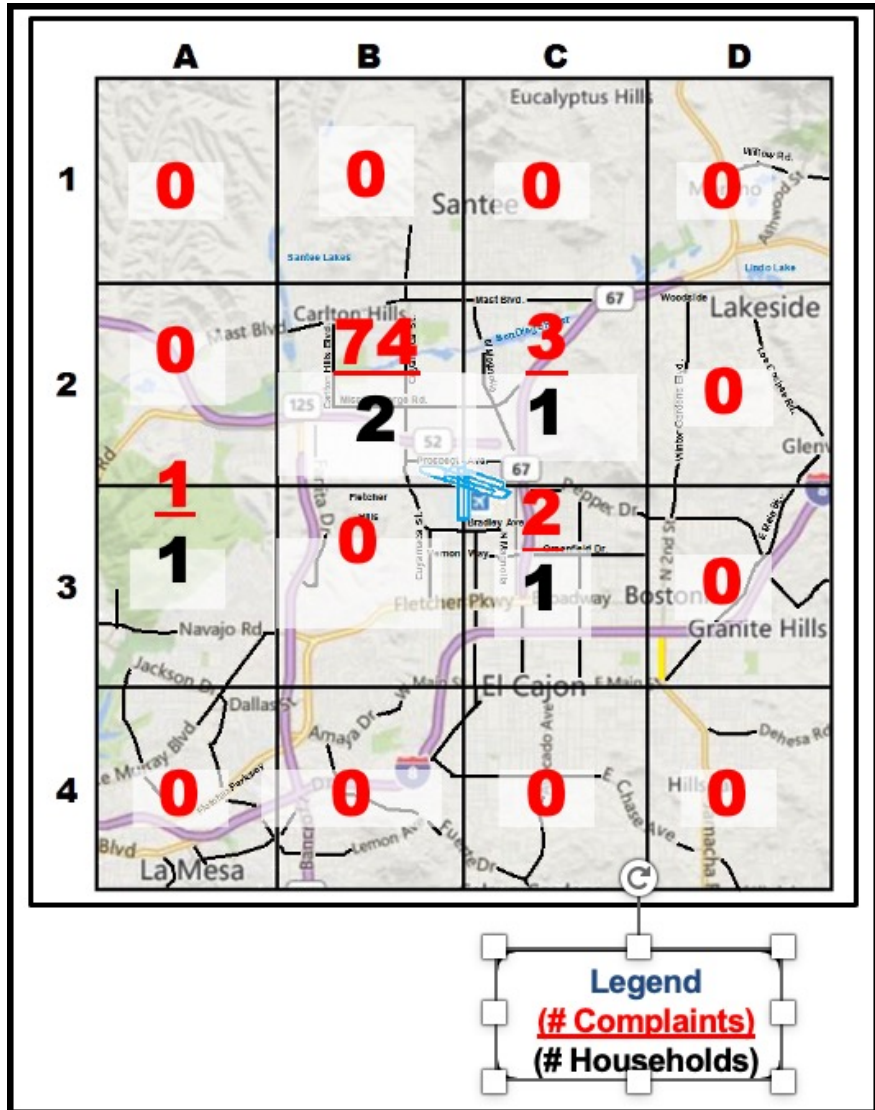

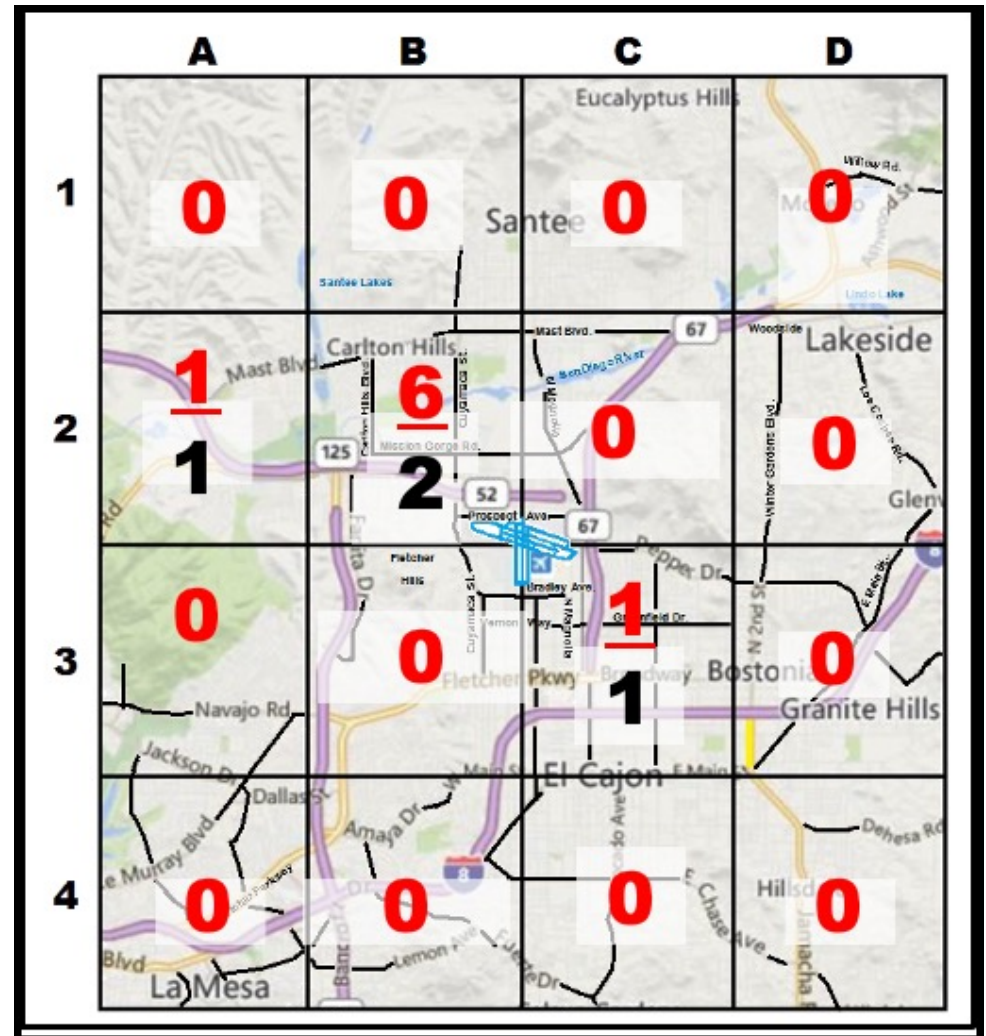
